Farm Manager –Lai Chi Wo Project

The farm manager will be responsible for the planning, management, operation, coordination, financial control and administration of activities for a farming and rural community revitalization project in Lai Chi Wo. He/she has to ensure the project is completed on time and within budget. He/she may also have a chance to work directly with the land and see visible results for his/her efforts. A sleeping quarter is provided when needed.

Responsibilities

- Lead a small team to carry out daily tasks, including rehabilitation, crop growing (paddy, vegetables, fruits and etc.) and promotion and selling of the farm produce
- Plan and execute construction and maintenance works, including drainage system reconstruction, access maintenance, repair of farm equipment and machinery and etc.
- Provide assistance to various educational farming activities
- Maintain accurate financial and other records, prepare farm log and update farm blog
- Prepare progress and financial reports on a regular basis and when needed

Requirements

- Effective project management, communication, interpersonal and team working skills
- Good administration and numeracy skills
- Solid local farming background with experience in growing wide range of crops
- Familiar with various farm tools, machinery and irrigation systems
- Willing to accept new methodologies and new challenges
- Practical, reliable, experienced, responsible, self-motivated and detail minded
- F.5 or above with minimum 3 years working experience
- Computer literacy in word processing, spreadsheets, internet and others
- Good command of both written and spoken Chinese and English
- 5 day work a week, including weekends and public holidays
